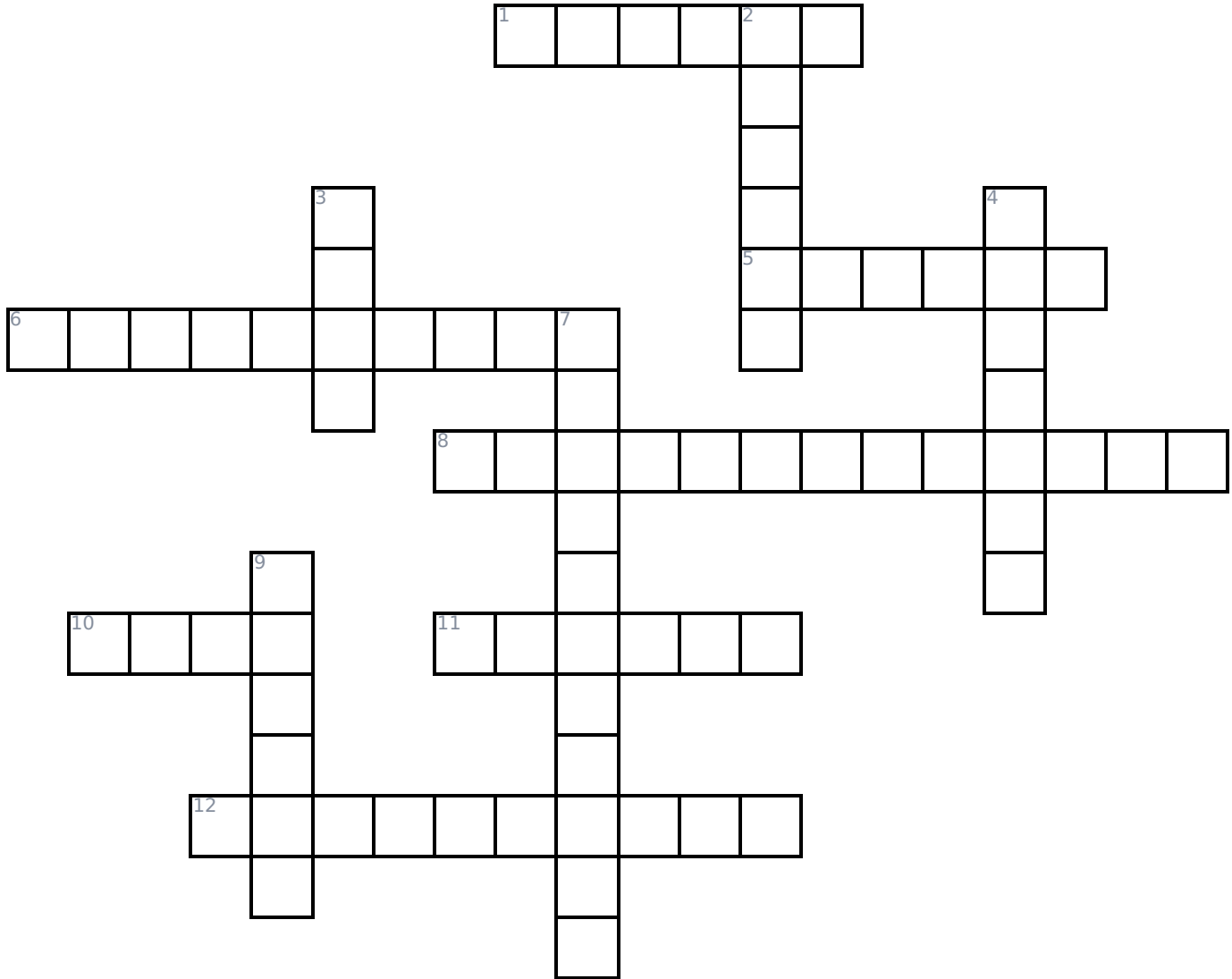


Amina's Voice: Criss Cross
