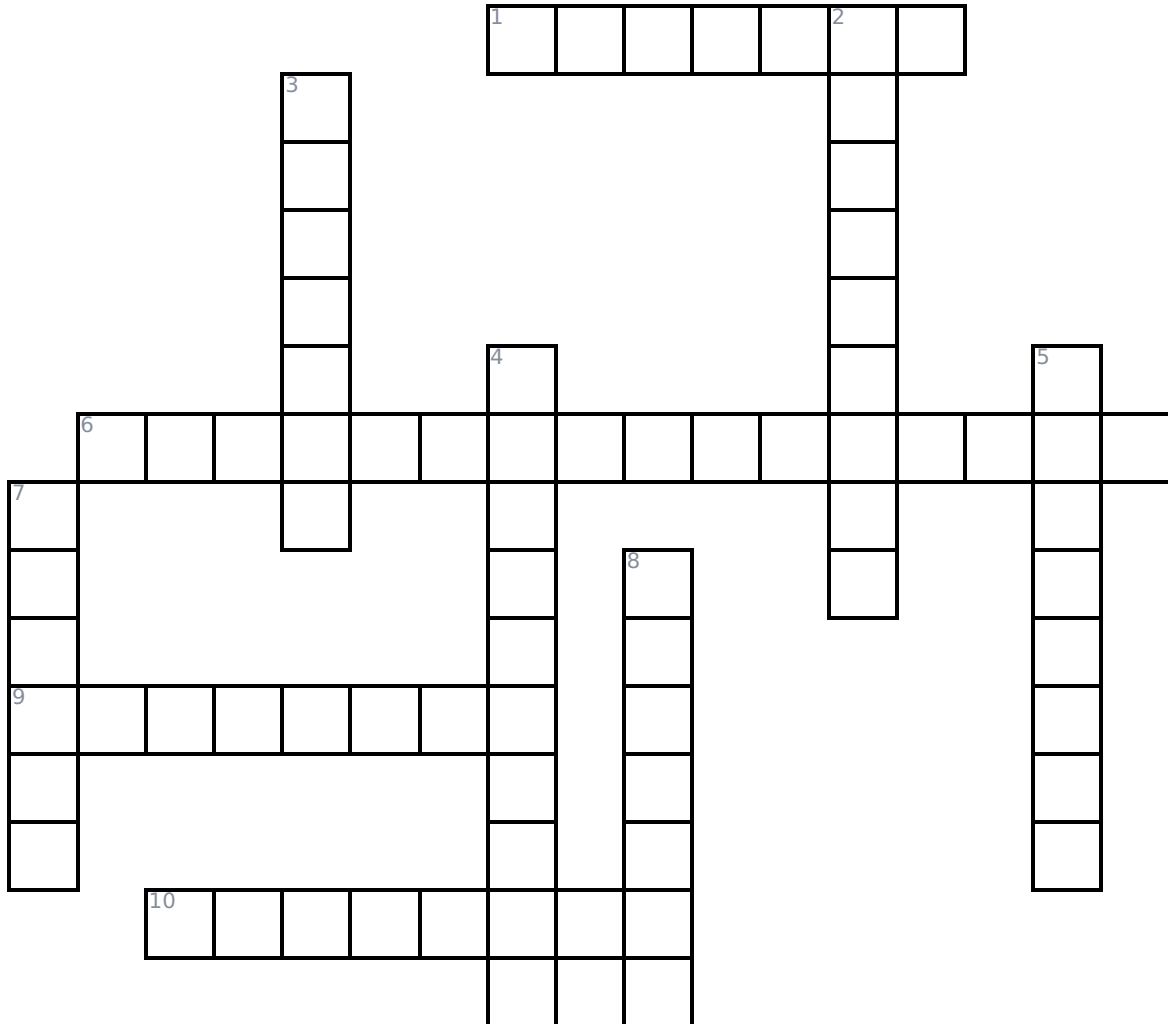


Buildings In Disguise: Criss Cross
