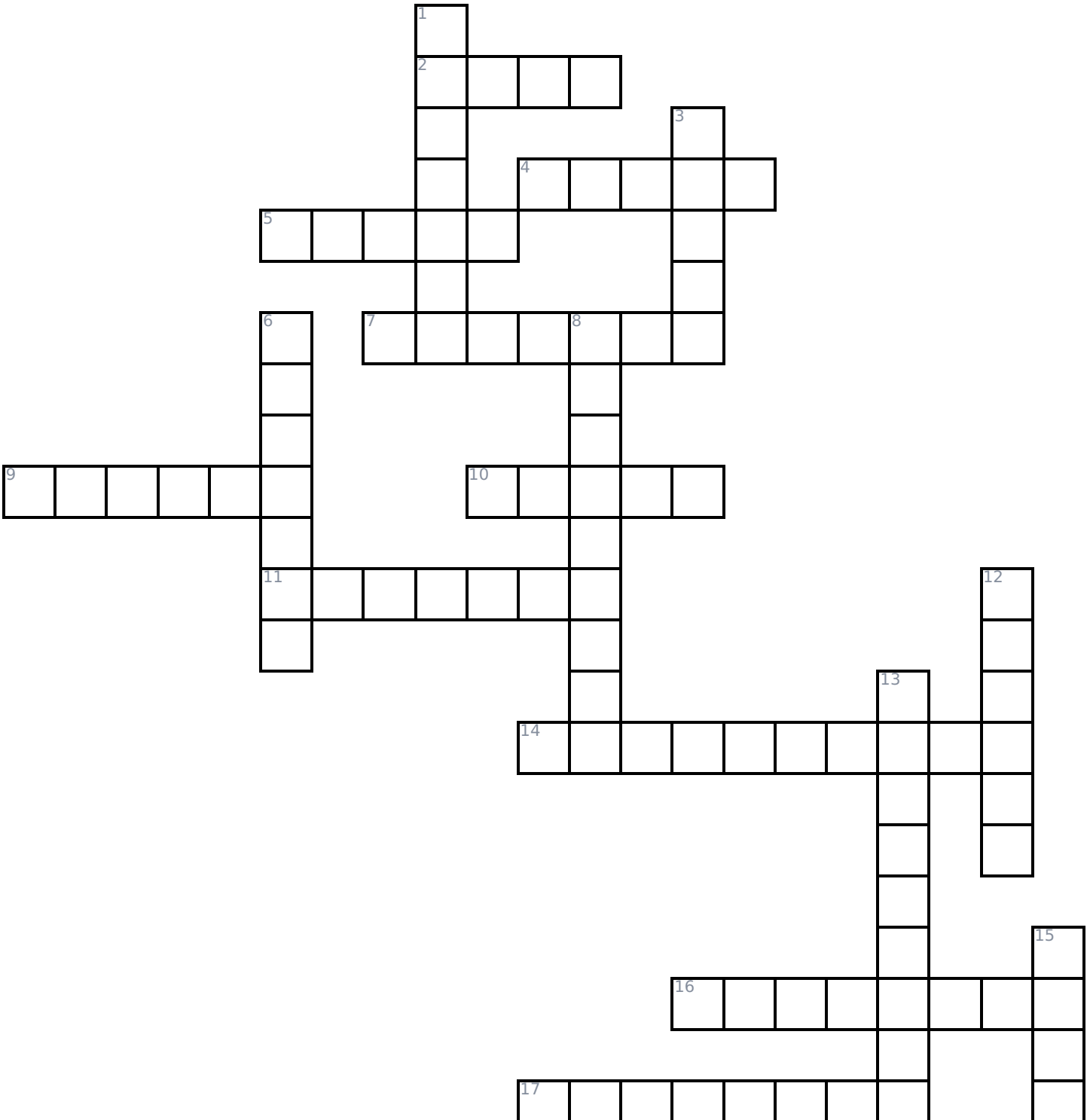
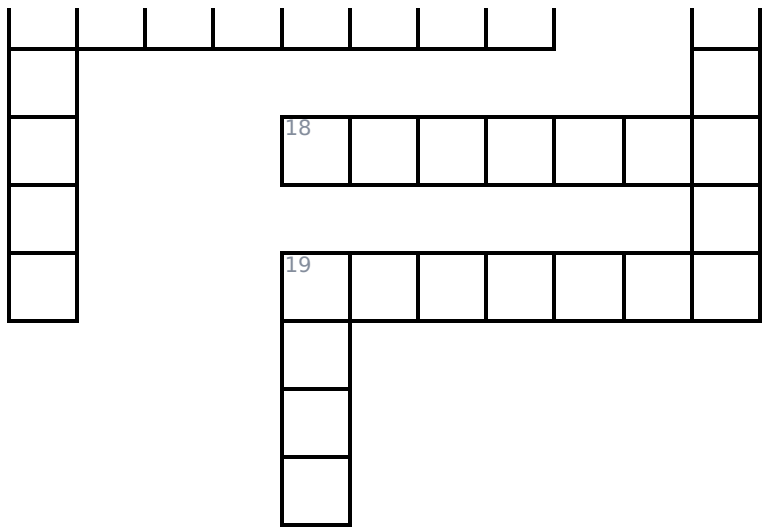


Choosing Brave: Criss Cross
