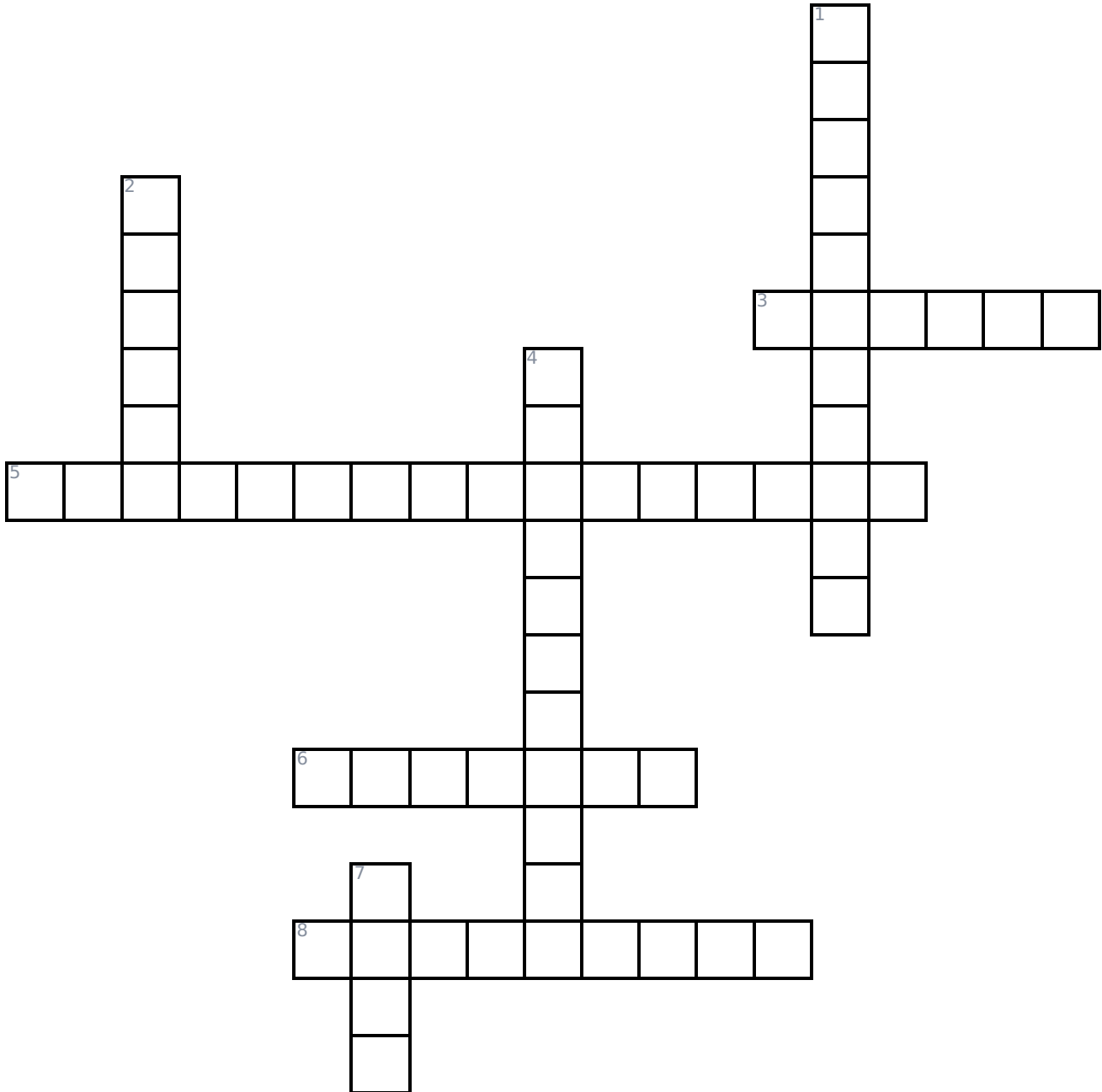


Common Ground: Criss Cross
