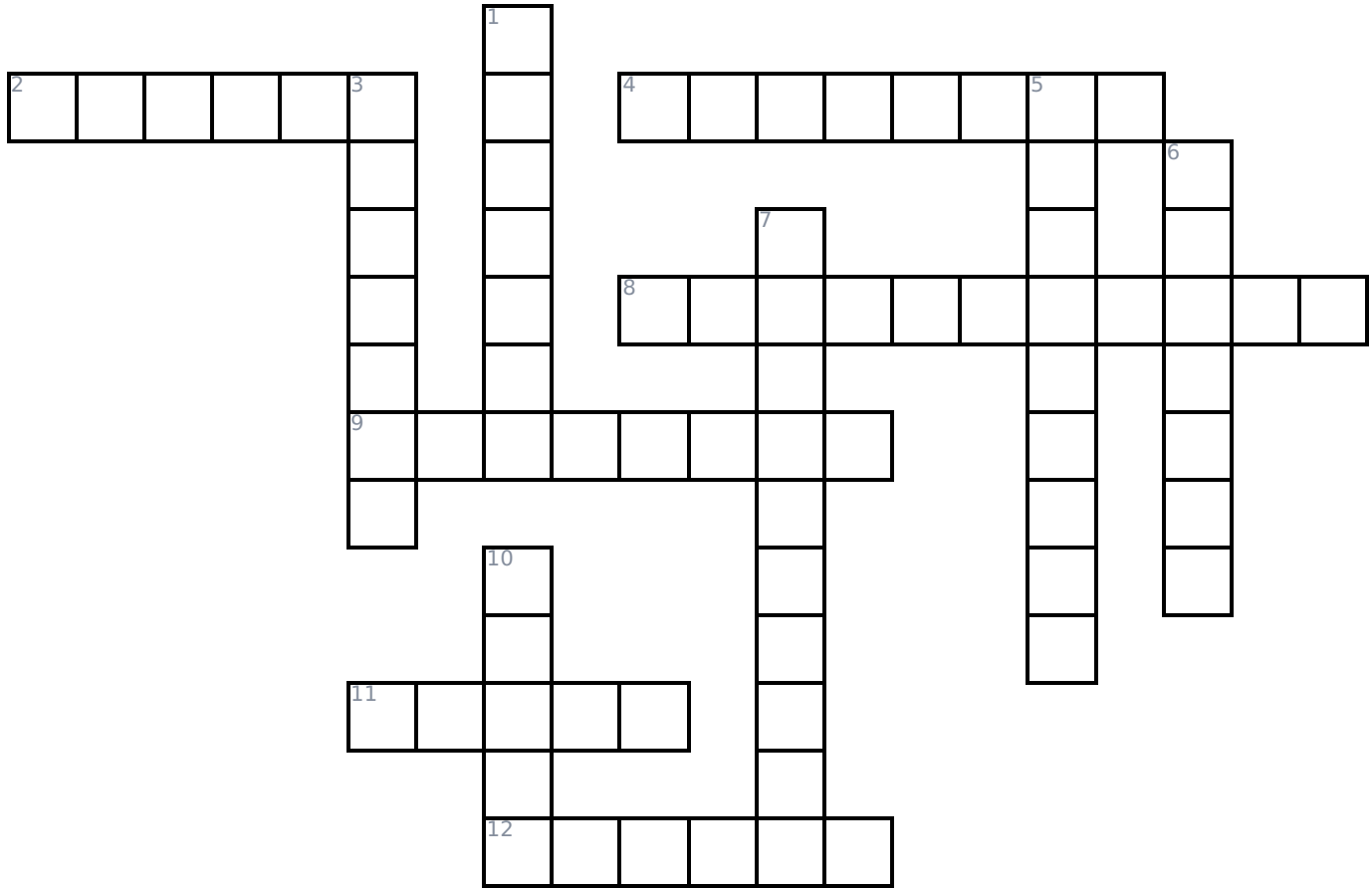


The Digestive System: Criss Cross
