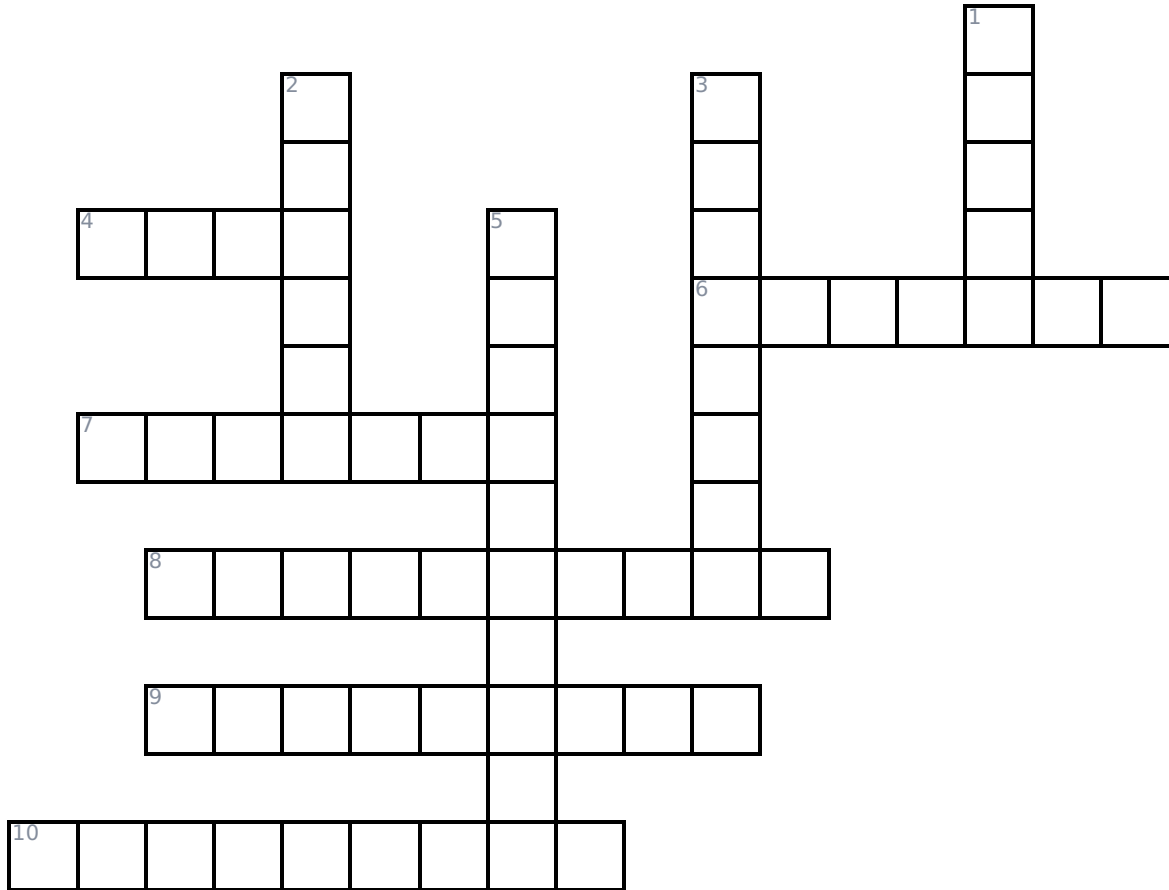


Fly Guy Presents: The White House: Criss Cross
