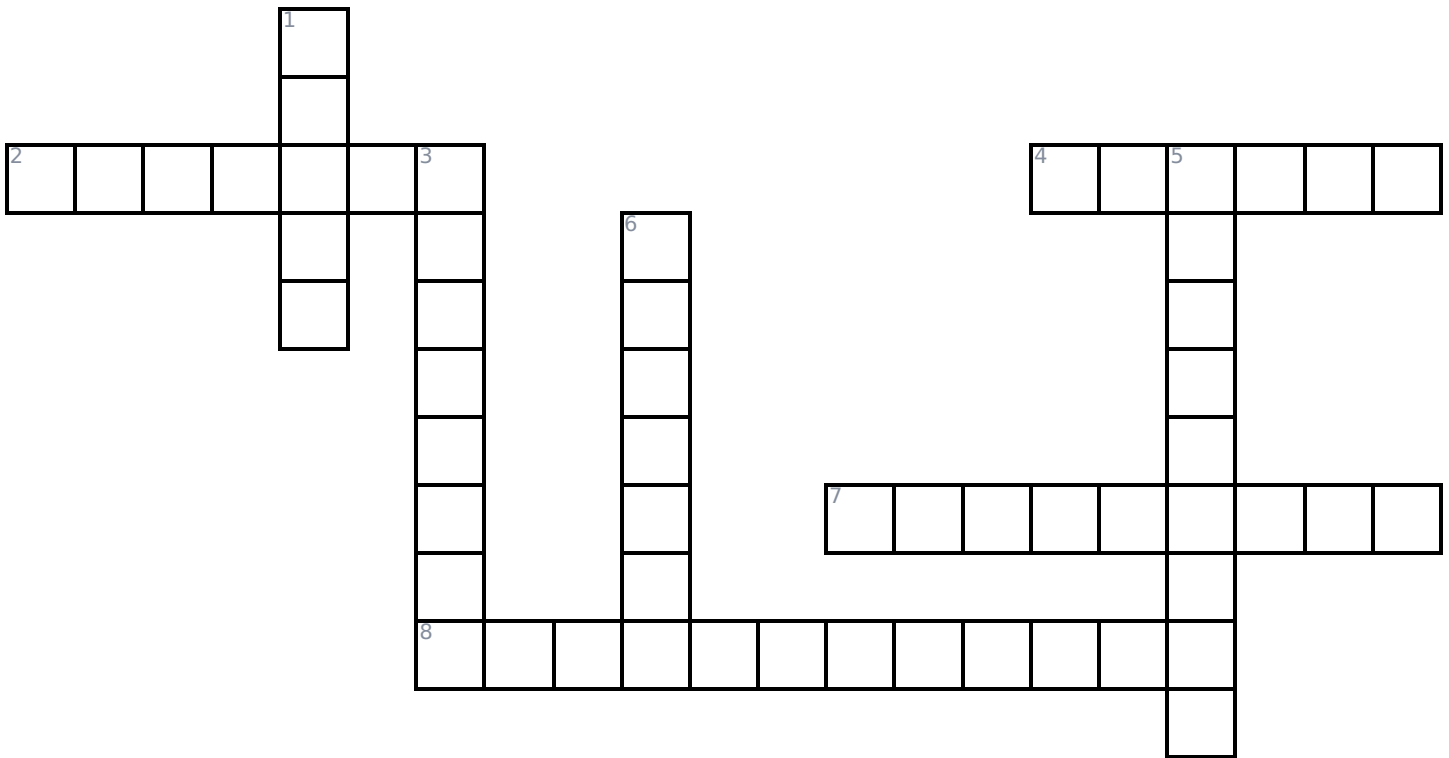


The Great Stink: Criss Cross
