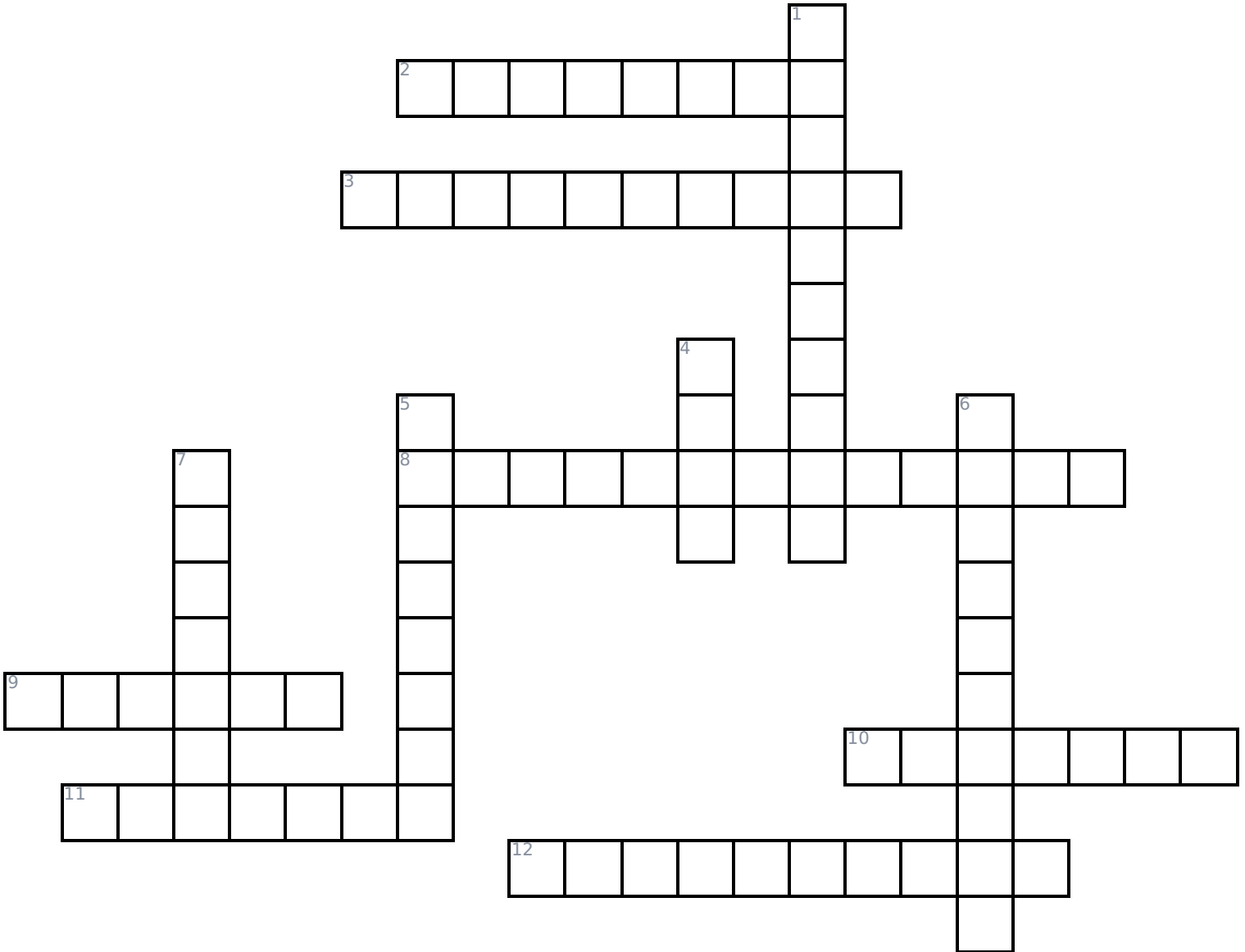


Look I'm a Scientist: Criss Cross (Medium)
