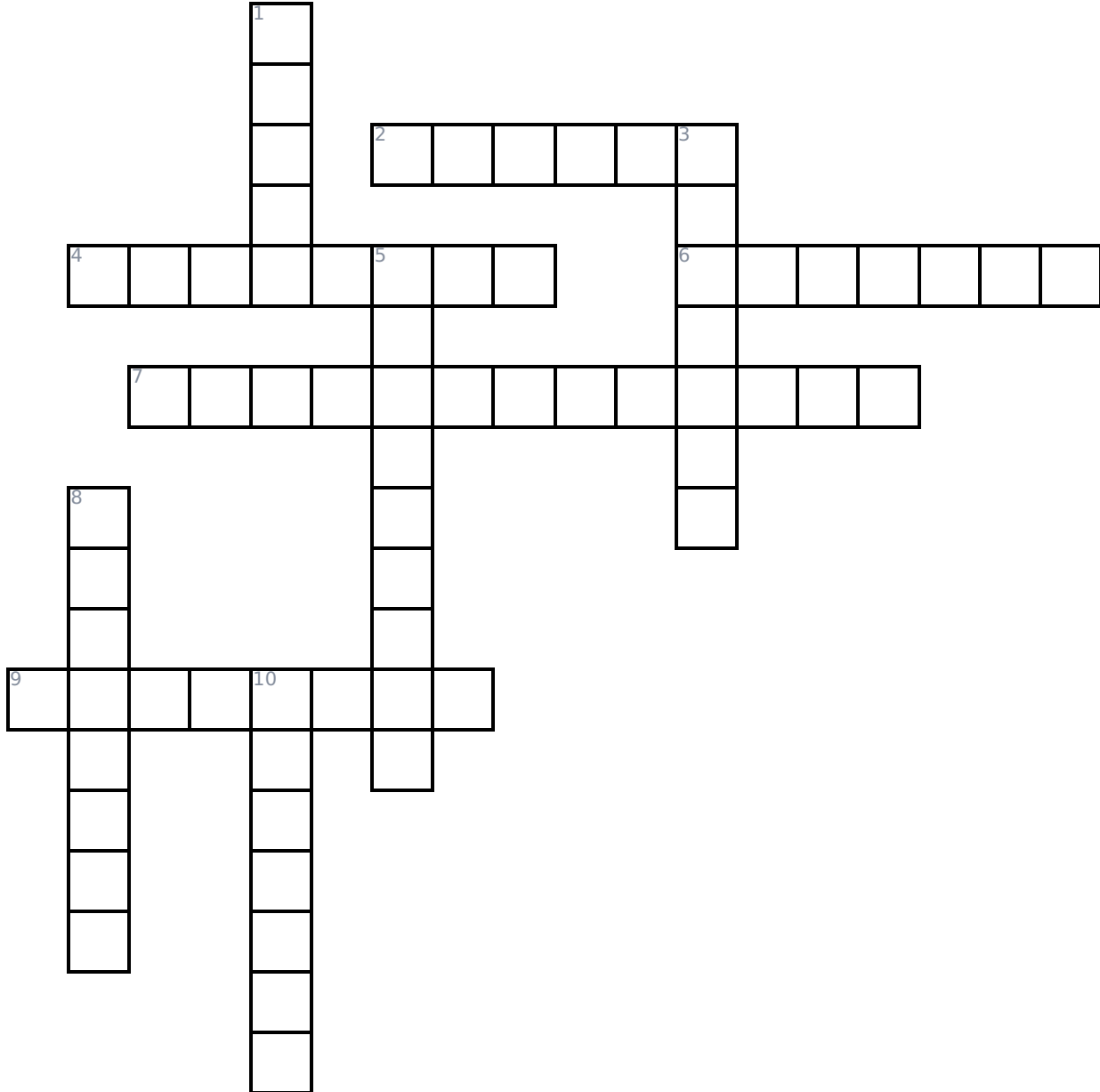


Malala's Magic Pencil: Criss Cross
