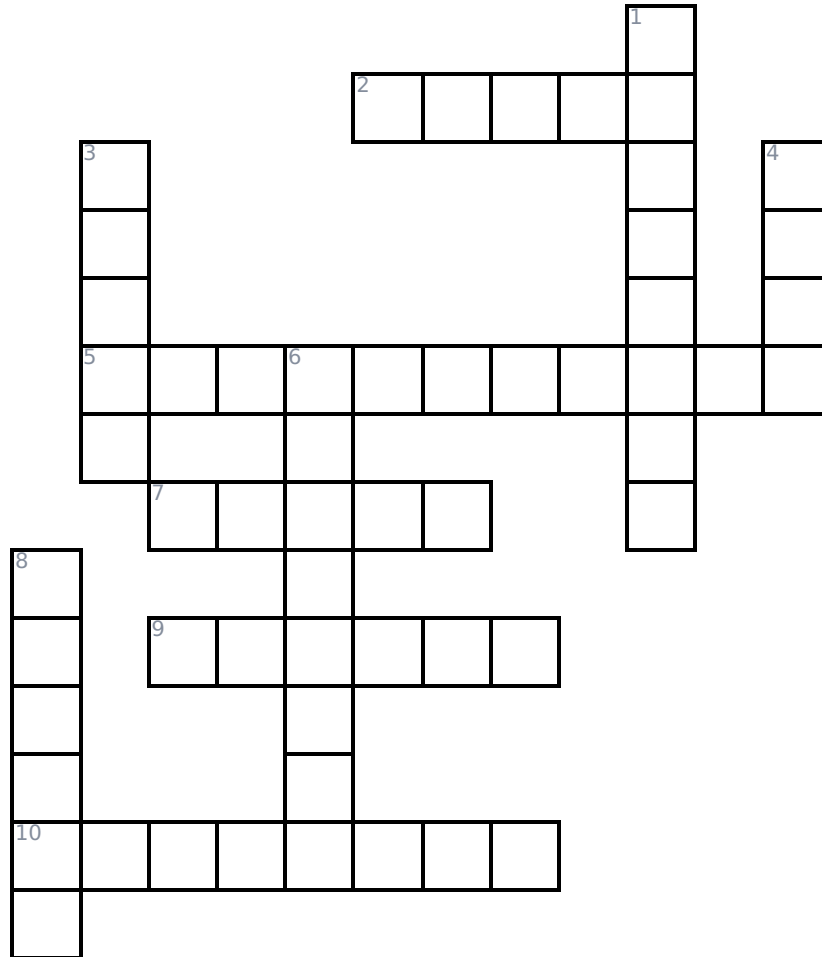


Technology: A Byte-Sized World!: Criss Cross
