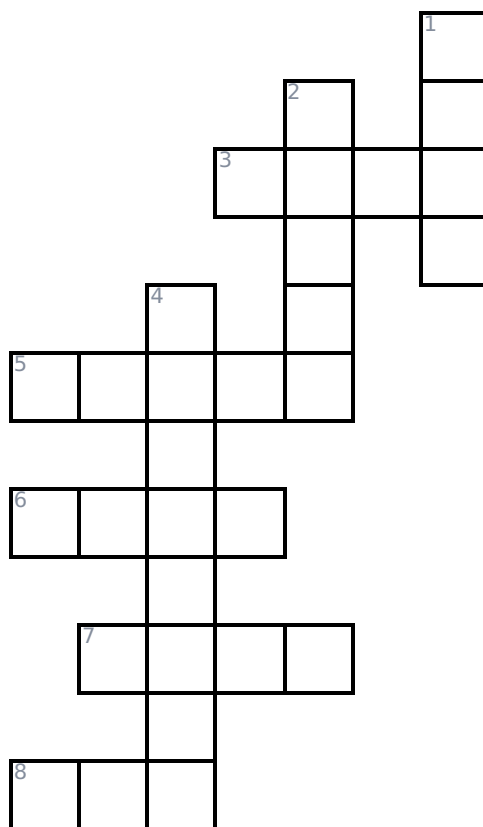


We've Got the Whole World in Our Hands: Criss Cross
