| Celestial p 105 | positioned in or relating to the sky, or outer space as observed in astronomy |
| Visual Cortex p 162 | the part of the cerebral cortex that receives and processes sensory nerve impulses from the eyes |
| Monitor(ed) p 164 | observe and check the progress or quality of (something) over a period of time; keep under systematic review |
