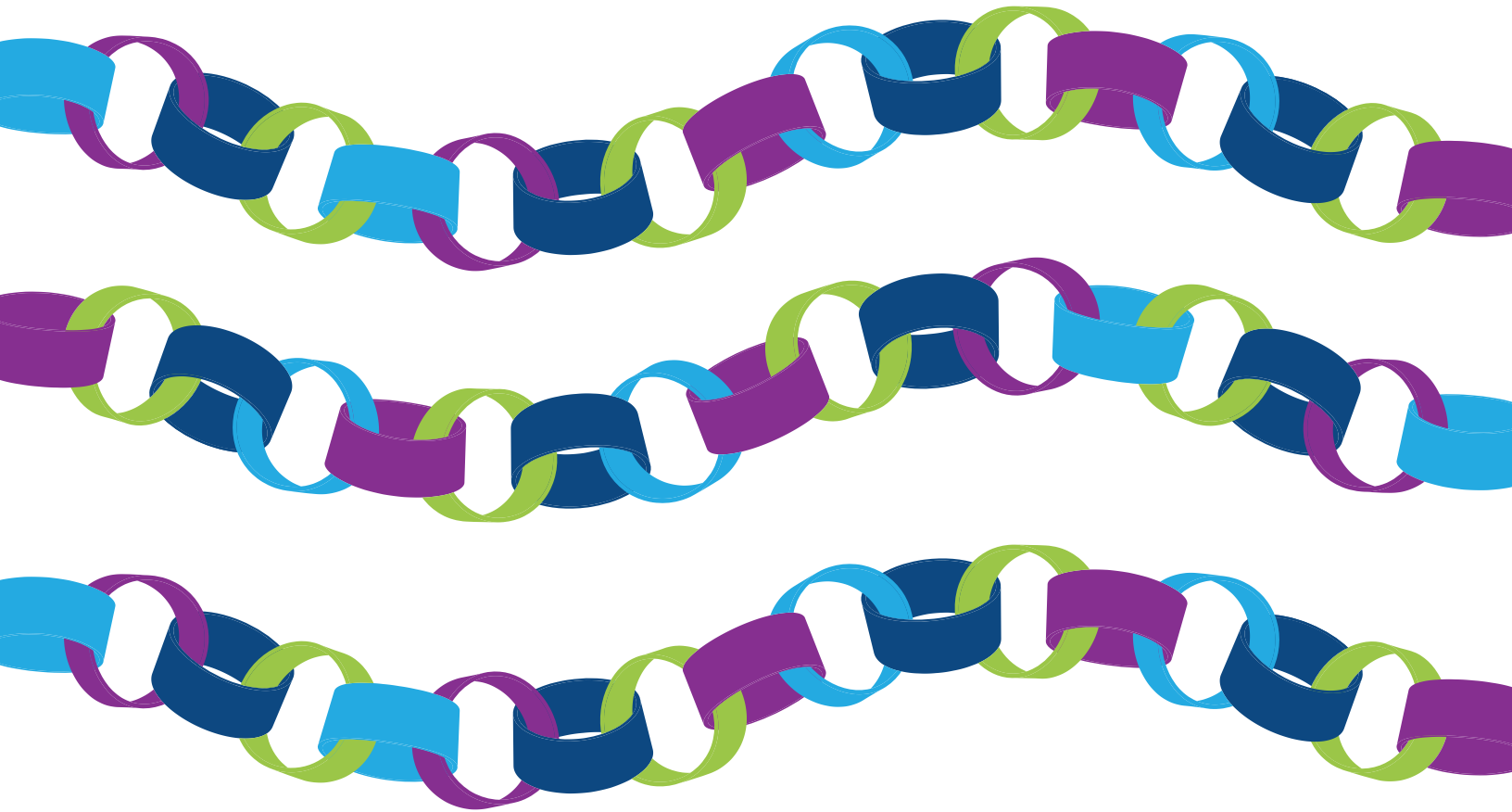
100 Years into the Future

100 Books Paper Chain

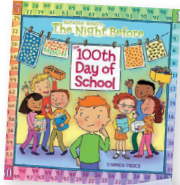

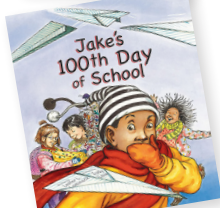

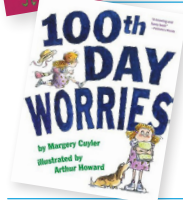
