A RIF GUIDE FOR FAMILIES


Themes: Community, Culture, Sharing

TIME TO READ!



Before reading, build background: Talk with your child about their favorite meal. Can they imagine the way the meal smells and the excitement they have when it's being made?

While reading, make connections: Do some of the people who come to Omu's door remind you of people from your own community? Talk about the people who might follow a delicious smell to your door to see about having a taste?

After reading, ask questions:

- What made people from the neighborhood knock on Omu's door?
- How did Omu react when people came to her door?
- When did Omu realize she'd run out of the red stew and didn't have any for herself?
- Why was Omu's dinner that night one of the best she'd ever had?

RELATED ACTIVITIES

GUESS THE SCOOPS

Materials: Bowl, ladle/spoon/scoop, water/dried beans/rice/etc.

Prepare a challenge that uses estimation skills to guess the number of scoops in a bowl. With as many participants as you like, allow time for

everyone to consider the amount in the bowl, estimate the number of "servings" that are there, and write down their guess. Encourage each participant to talk about their process (how did they make their estimate). Then, scoop and count until the bowl is empty. Award nonmaterial prizes, such as choose your seat or enjoy the first serving.



MENU WRITING

Materials: Paper, writing utensil

Select a meal to highlight in your home. Talk about MENU the dishes you'll be serving for the meal and have your child Vegatable Soup write a menu for the Tomatos table. Include names Garlic and descriptions of the celery dishes. Encourage your child to use the five pasta senses in their cheese descriptions.
