

The Mitten


READ ALOUD GUIDE

Themes: Animals, sharing and community, winter

Book Brief: Nicki loses his white mitten in the snow, and one by one, woodland animals crawl in, from a mole to a bear, creating a hilarious climax when a tiny mouse joins them. Meanwhile, the reader glimpses Nicki's snowy adventure in the page borders.

BEFORE READING

The Cover: Have students make predictions about the story based on the cover.

The Pictures: Take a brief picture walk and ask students what they notice about the mitten.

Prior Knowledge: Ask students, "How would you feel if you lose something special to you?"

Vocabulary: Frontload Tier 2 words using the accompanying Vocabulary Guide.

Purpose for Reading: "As we read today, pay attention to Nicki's adventures with his new white gloves."

DURING READING

Check for understanding & make connections:

- Ask students to predict which animals Nicki will find on his travels by looking in the page borders.
- Where did the animals go? Why?
- Why did the animals keep letting the new animals in?

AFTER READING

Our Purpose: Nicki returns home with his two white gloves, but one is larger. Explain what happened.

Extending Our Thinking: Nicki's mitten encounters many animals. Using <u>RIF's Writing Template</u>, have students retell the story of Nicki and his white mittens.
