Heaven	Student-friendly definition
tempt	to try to persuade someone to do something by making it seem attractive
erupt	a sudden increase in activity or emotion
imminent	something that will happen very soon
precautionary	done in order to prevent something dangerous or unpleasant from happening
vulnerability	someone who can be easily harmed or hurt
embrace	to put your arms around someone and hold them in a friendly or loving way

scrounge	to get money or something you want by asking other people for it rather than by paying for it yourself
accumulate	to gradually increase in numbers or amount until there is a large quantity in one place
mangle	to damage or injure something badly by crushing or twisting it
decompose	to decay or make something decay
assess	to make a judgment about a person or situation after thinking carefully about it
meander	having a lot of bends rather than going in a straight line
presence	when someone or something is present in a particular place
emanate	to produce a smell, light etc, or to show a particular quality

clench	to hold something tightly in your hand or between your teeth
intent	giving careful attention to something so that you think about nothing else
materialize	to happen or appear in the way that you expected
unrelenting	an unpleasant situation that continues for a long time without stopping
venture	a new business activity that involves taking risks

Peril	Student-friendly definition
incomprehensible	difficult or impossible to understand
fissure	a deep crack, especially in rock or earth
arduous	involving a lot of strength and effort
vulnerable	someone who can be easily harmed or hurt
unfurl	Something that unrolls and opens

Desolation	Student-friendly definition
palpable	a feeling that is so strong that other people notice it and can feel it around them
bleak	without anything to make you feel happy or hopeful
devoured	to destroy someone or something
obliterated	to destroy something completely so that nothing remains
undeterred	you do not allow it to stop you doing what you want
ferocity	the state of being extremely violent and severe

tribulations	serious trouble or a serious problem
pensive	thinking a lot about something, especially because you are worried or sad

agonizing	extremely painful
enshrine	something that is preserved and protected so that people will remember and respect it
boisterous	someone that makes a lot of noise and has a lot of energy
