

The 100th Customer


READ ALOUD GUIDE

Themes: Caring, Family, Friendship, Generosity, Giving, Kindness

Book Brief: Ben Bear and Chris Croc run a pizza restaurant and surprise a boy and his grandmother by pretending he's their 100th customer, giving them free food. This heartwarming story shows how kindness can bring joy and unexpected rewards.

BEFORE READING

The Cover: Have students make predictions about the story based on the cover.

The Pictures: Take a brief picture walk and ask students what they notice about the boy.

Prior Knowledge: Ask students, "What is something that warms your heart?" (makes you happy)

Vocabulary: Frontload Tier 2 words using the accompanying Vocabulary Guide.

Purpose for Reading: "As we read today, watch how the restaurant celebrates their 100th customer."

DURING READING

Check for understanding & make connections:

- · What did Ben Bear learn from the boy and grandma?
- · Explain why the boy was moving rocks.
- How did Ben Bear make sure the boy was the 100th customer?
- Why do you think the boy called his grandma?

AFTER READING

Our Purpose: Ben Bear and Cris Croc created a celebration for the 100th customer each day. How did this impact the community?

Extending Our Thinking Using RIF's Recipe Card, have students create a friendship pie. What toppings would you use and what would they represent.
