

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

• Read aloud the title of the story. Flip through a couple of illustrations and ask to make predictions about what the story is going to teach them.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What is this page teaching us about?
- Why is the author making a change on this page?
- How does this change help the earth?

After Reading: Ask Questions

• What is something new you learned from this book? How can you help the earth?
