


Discussion Guide for Families

Themes: Environment and Sustainability

Book Brief: A pancake house wants to open a franchise in Florida, but the site under consideration is where endangered owls live. A newcomer to the neighborhood, Roy Eberhardt, joins forces with other kids to stop construction and save the owls.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

• Look at the title and cover of the book. What do you think the story might be about?

While Reading: Make Connections

- What three words would you use to describe Roy at the beginning of the book?
- How does Roy change as the story goes on? What causes these changes?
- Why is Roy so determined to protect the owls and their home?

After Reading: Ask Questions

Do you think anyone can be a farmer? Why or why not?
