

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

Ask your child "Why do you think it's important to protect and preserve the environment?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- Why do you think Rachel Carson became so passionate about protecting the environment?
- What role did Congress and the President play in helping to protect the environment during Rachel Carson's time?
- Rachel Carson faced challenges as a woman in science during her time. Why do you think she was able to succeed in her work despite these obstacles?

After Reading: Ask Questions

 Create a timeline of Rachel Carson's life, starting with her interest in science as a child, through her college years, and her adult work as a scientist and author. What impact did her books and work have on protecting the environment?
