Book Brief: An exciting adventure story about a group of kids who think they're stranded on a deserted island and must work together to survive!

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "If you were on an island, what would you do to stay safe? Who would you want with you?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What do the kids think has happened to them? How do they feel?
- What do the kids do to try to survive? How do they work together?
- Who finds the kids? What surprising news does he tell them?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "What did the kids think at first? What was really happening? How did working together help them?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Play "Teamwork Challenge." Set up simple tasks at home that require working together (like building a blanket fort, creating an obstacle course, or organizing toys). Talk about how everyone's ideas and help made the task easier and more fun, just like the kids worked together on the island.
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
