FACE COLLAGE

Materials: magazines, scissors, glue, construction paper

- 1. Cut out different parts of faces from magazine pictures.
- 2. Glue parts together onto paper to create a unique face.
- 3. What do you see in the face you have created?
- 4. Write a poem about the face to go with your collage.



FACE PHOTOS

Materials: camera, printer, paper, pencils

Take a picture of a friend (or several). Once the pictures are printed, write a poem that describes each picture. Display for all to see!

POETRY JOURNAL

Create a poetry journal. Each day pick one experience to write a poem about. Use different poem types: haiku, acrostic, diamante, free verse, ballad and so on. Illustrations, pictures from magazines/computer or photos make a nice book.
