- **BEE DECLINE** Lower numbers of bees caused by climate change, loss of habitat, disease, and pesticides
 - **BEEHIVES** Where beekeepers keep their bees
- **BEEKEEPERS** Humans who keep bees in beehives and understand how bees work
 - **BEESWAX** Used by honeybees to make hexagonal cells that make up a honeycomb
 - **COLONY** A large group of honeybees that live together
- **DRONE BEES** Male bees who are pushed out of the hive in the fall
 - **HONEY** Made from collected nectar, food for bees and humans
 - **NECTAR** A sweet, sticky liquid made by flowers
 - **NEST** Where a colony of honeybees lives
 - **POLLEN** A powder made by flowers, food for baby bees
- POLLINATION The process of moving pollen from one flower to another that helps flowers reproduce and helps crops to grow
- POLLINATORS Animals who move pollen from flower to flower
 - OUEEN BEE Mother to most of the bees in the hive
- **OUEEN SCENT** A special scent the queen gives off to let the colony know she is alive and healthy
 - **ROBOBEE** An artificial bee developed by scientists to help solve the problem of bee decline
 - **SWARM** A large group of honeybees flying together
- **WAGGLE DANCE** How bees communicate inside the hive to let each other know where the best flowers are
 - WORKER BEES Female bees who clean, guard the hive, and make honey
