## Enemy Pie

## (ENEMY) PIE CHART

Explore fractions by making a class pie chart. Ask students what their favorite kind of pie (or dessert) is and put the answers on the board. Then, do the math to create a pie chart.

- Start with the number in the class. "There are 24 of us. We make that number the denominator and write it like this: /24."
- Move on to favorites: "How many like strawberry pie? Six? Okay. That number is
the numerator. So $6 / 24$ or $1 / 4$ of our class pie strawberry pie? Six? Okay. That number is
the numerator. So $6 / 24$ or $1 / 4$ of our class pie is strawberry."
Students can also be put into small groups and asked to create their own group pie chart.



## FRIENDSHIP BOOK

Give every student a sheet of paper and ask them to draw a picture of or write a story about a favorite adventure with their best friend.

Put the stories into a notebook or bind them together with ribbon or yarn to make a class book.
